The Regional Conference can be custom tailored to fit your needs. It can also be shortened to a Four Day Mini-Regional. All events EXCEPT for the *One-Day Seminar* are open to the public and FREE (an offering will be received at each session).

The One-Day Seminars are \$50 general admission, \$40 seniors/students. However, Preaching Peace has a policy that 'no one is turned away for lack of funds.' Local sponsorships help us underwrite this policy. Please contact us regarding bringing on local sponsors.

**Here is what we need you to do to be the host of your region:
(The host may be an individual or a group)**

1. Gather a local list (we suggest within a 20-30 minute driving time) that has a **minimum of 60 pastors'/lay leaders'**

- Names
- Church/Street addresses
- E-mail addresses.

These could include people from any group, church or denomination that you think or hope might be willing to promote or recommend any part of the conference to their church/group members.

2. Personally locate 2 churches that would be willing to host the Sunday Kick-off and Sunday Wrap-up of the Conference (may or may not be the same).

3. Locate and reserve local forums (large area church, community center, college campus assembly hall, etc.) where we can hold the workshop, the seminars, and the two luncheons (restaurant with adequate meeting room). It is preferred that the location for each of these events is different in order to spread out the wealth and interest! Keep in mind we want to reach out to as many different groups as possible, including young adults.

4. Give us the Names and contact info of 2 to 4 local publications/newspapers that tend to be used and read by the community and the local churches.

5. Arrange the provision of rooms and meals for the Hardin's and One-Day Seminar speakers during the conference/one day event. We are happy to stay with church members and take meals with families. Arranging transportation to and from airport is host responsibility.

Preaching Peace will then e-mail to the individuals in step #1:

- Invitations to these pastors/leaders to promote the conference
- Detailed descriptions of the seminars/events
- Bulletin inserts
- Posters, Flyers
- Details of the Jesus Driven Life (Group Starter Kit)
- Announce or Advertise the conference in the recommended publications

We will continue to be in close contact with you up through the event for additional guidance and assistance that may be required for your area.
